FBS&HN Programs include:

### Annual Meeting

- To share ideas between Farm Bureau safety and health professionals
- To update Farm Bureau staff on relevant national safety and health issues
- To improve professional skills and knowledge of Farm Bureau staff

### ASAP (Agricultural Safety Awareness Program)

- To reduce the number of farm work-related injuries and deaths by increasing safety and health awareness and promoting safe practices
- To create media releases and educational materials promoting safety and health in agricultural and rural communities
- To increase public awareness of the importance of safety and health in agriculture

### Grainger Discounts

- To reduce the overall cost of safety and health products for agricultural and rural communities
- To create a central point for ordering safety supplies
- To offer a wider variety of safety and health products

### Networking

- To open communication channels between Farm Bureau safety and health professionals and volunteers
